Dollar Bill Brewing is a Barrel aged sour beer focused brewery and cidery with a passion for sustainable agriculture and manufacturing practices. Off grid on seven acres north of Ballarat, this small brewery has had a multitude of successes after their first product release in 2016. Achieving the coveted title of AIBA Champion Gypsy brewers in 2023 and AIBA Champion Australian beers in 2021 and 2023 along with the IBA Champion Australian beer in 2023. Their difficult to find spontaneous and wild fermented beers are aged for up to four years before being blended with sustainable grown parcels of specially selected fruit. Soon to open a small bar in Ballarat, however a selection of their products are available at select independent bars and bottle shops in Ballarat.
